The Chairperson brought the meeting to order at 6:00 pm exactly, and noted that there were no guests to introduce.

There were no Incoming Claims or Communications.

Under Financial Matters, the Chairperson noted that the District received the first half of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter's DOAP, and the district is waiting on the second half.
